

WPTT-4H8 User manual (Hytera radio)

1. For entering the pairing mode in the WPTT-4H8, a compatible headset with 4-pole 3.5 mm connector must be plugged in the WPTT-4H8 phone jack.
(Note: If you remove the 4-pin 3.5 mm connector from the WPTT-4H8, the Bluetooth devices will stop working.)
2. Turn the knob clockwise on the top of the Hytera radio to turn on the power while pressing the PTT button on the WPTT-4H8 for entering the pairing mode.
(Note: Press the PTT button for about 10 seconds to enter pairing mode.)
3. The LED blue light would flash 2 times every 2 seconds if WPTT-4H8 entered to pairing mode.
(Note: If it is not in the pairing mode, the LED blue light would flash 1 time every 1 second.)
4. Please notice the Bluetooth accessory, PTT-Z-L0, needs to be turned on, then it can pair with the WPTT-4H8 while it is in pairing mode.
(Note: There should be only one PTT-Z-L0 be opened in the surrounding of WPTT-4H8 while pairing.)
